

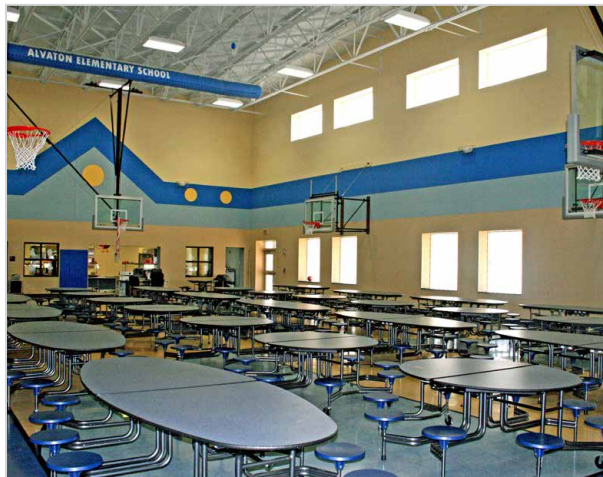

- Energy efficiency and conservation are top priority of the school district. As a result, numerous building systems and sustainable architecture concepts were evaluated and incorporated in the school.
- These include:
 - Sandwich panel metal roof system, achieving an R-30 insulation value
 - Geothermal heat pump system
 - Lighting and HVAC occupancy sensors.
 - Green building finishes
 - Natural day lighting.
- Two story K – Grade 5 elementary school with upper and lower class-room wings totaling 77,000 sq. ft. This project utilized NUDURA® 12" on the gymnasium and 8" Forms on the core area of the building.
